Roscommon which is ? of Victoria Queen of United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland born Jan 6 1839 and is now thirty three, he arrived at Boston on April 20 1869. All of which appears in the record of the Honorable Superior Court of Massachusetts to wit on the 20th day of March 1872. It is witnessed by Michael Skeffinghn(237 Broadway) and Patrick Skeffinghm(87 Willis) both of Lowell.

His declaration of intent also states that he emigrated from Queenstown.

Checking the City directories starting in 1893 it appears he is no longer living with his wife. But at the time of his death 20 years later he is living with his wife, so its not clear if they separated or not.

Dear Ginny - It was great to hear from you and especially in regard to the research that you are doing. I'm so thankful that you are sharing this information with me. This is exciting! I will try to make corrections (from what I think I know) and answer your questions. I hope I can make them clear enough so as not to confuse you! I am rather convinced that DONOUGHUE is the correct spelling. I'm quite sure that John Donoughue's sister was Mary Ann Donoughue Stacy married to Walter Stacy (a meat cutter) of Lawrence MA. They had 3 daughters Marion V, Louise and Helen and 3 sons Walter II, Raymond (and Allen(Alan)?). Marion and Louise were elem school teachers in Lawrence and never married. Helen, also a teacher married Thomas? Connelly, they had one son Thomas. Walter was married and had I think 3 sons. Raymond married had a son and twin sons. Marion, Louise, Helen, Walter and Raymond, my mother's cousins, she often visited with them in Lawrence at 51 Smith St from before I was born until Marion died about late 1980s. Louise died previous to Marion. Last I knew Helen's husband Tom had died and she suffered a stroke and was in a nursing home.

I never heard that John and Mary Ann Donoughue had other siblings (yes a brother Michael. Mary (T's) sister was adopted from a Catholic home, either Lawrence or Lowell. I would estimate between 1905 and 1915. The four children of John Donoughue and Catherine (Kate) Robinson Donoughue were placed in this home about 1904. Parents separated (divorced) Kate worked in a "Business Man's Club" (as my mother Mary said). Kate (Catherine) was married to John? Frank? Dorian at least when I was about 10-12 so that would have been in the 1940s (or before). Catherine (Kate) was found dead in bed by daughter Mary Theresa Pinney about late 1960s or in the 70s. Kate (Catherine) lived at that time in a 1-2 room apt in Boston. I know it was a poorer section but I can't remember street unless it was Boylston St. Mary's brother John Edward was referred to as "Eddie" by Mary and her grandmother. Mary often gave up her \$3-\$6.00 weeks pay so Eddie could have new shoes, as requested by their grandomother. Most of the time Mary was allowed to keep only \$.50 out of her pay; grandmother took remainder. I got the impression that "Eddie" didn't work much.

Well Ginny I hope at least some of my notes and copys are helpful to you. Please keep in touch. Happy New Year, Leone

You are welcome to keep all included in this package.

My mother's father, to my knowledge never came to visit her. He may have died in NY but I don't know why I think this.
